

Long Prairie Country Club Policies

General Policies

I. TEE TIMES

- A. Members may make tee times one month in advance
- B. Non-members may make tee times two weeks in advance
- C. Special circumstances allow where the manager will make tee times further in advance to accommodate large groups

II. GENERAL COURSE DAY

- A. Fivesomes will be allowed on the golf course under the discretion of the club manager and or staff. It is mandatory that three carts are in each group. **There will be no more than 2 leased carts allowed per foursome and 3 leased carts per fivesome.**
- B. All golfers must “**sign in**” in the pro shop before teeing off.
- C. Upon checking in, pro shop staff will direct you to the designated starting hole.
- D. All beverages consumed on the course or bar area must be purchased through the country club. All others will be confiscated.
- E. Each golfer must have their own set of clubs. Rental clubs are offered.
- F. Golfer’s 13 and under must be accompanied by an adult on weekends and holidays. On weekdays, juniors 13 and under may be asked to give up their tee time if the day is busy.
- G. Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times on the course and clubhouse.
- H. Metal spikes are not allowed. This is a soft spike facility.

III. SPECIAL DAYS

- A. Wednesday’s are Men’s days. The last tee time available for general public and lady members is 11:52AM. Course closes, for the men, at 12:00 PM and will reopen for general play at 5:37.
- B. Thursday’s are ladies days. The last tee time will be 1:52pm for the 9-holes the ladies will be playing. 9-holes will remain open to the public; with all 18 reopening at 6pm.
- C. Ladies bridge will be added to schedule when possible. Usually every other Monday.

Note: If any special day falls on a legal holiday, holiday play takes preference for the clubhouse and course.

- A. Men’s League
- B. Ladies League
- C. Tuesday league
- D. Couples League
- E. All LPCC sponsored tournaments

V. POWER GOLF CARTS

- A. All rented carts must be driven by a person with a valid driver's license. Rental carts must be signed in as well, when signing in for your tee time.
- B. Privately owned golf carts must be accompanied by a person with a valid driver's license.
- C. No more than two persons allowed on a cart at any time
- D. There is no longer private cart storage for members. Those members with storage have been grandfathered in.
- E. All privately owned carts must be registered with LPCC.
- F. Members who use their own carts will be charged a trail fee.
- G. Non-Members may use their own cart for a fee of \$8.00.
- H. LPCC suggests personal carts not be loaned to others, besides immediate family.
- I. Power carts are to remain at least 30 feet from the green, unless on a path.
- J. Anyone with a handicap should ask for a special permit at the pro shop.
- K. Those paying for single cart rental for the season may not let others ride for free. Those others must pay a normal ½ cart rental fee.
- L. Those paying for family cart rental for the season may let anyone else ride at no additional charge.

VI. GREENS FEE AND OTHER FEES

- A. Greens fee for weekend and holidays will be greater than weekdays.
- B. Power golf carts will be available to rent.
- C. Golf clubs will be available to rent.
- D. Pull carts will be available to rent.
- E. Club storage lockers will be available to rent.

VII. MEMBERSHIP

- A. Stockholder membership shall be less than non-stock memberships.
- B. There shall be single memberships, couple memberships, family memberships, and student memberships. Prices will be reviewed each year.
- C. Family memberships
 - 1. Individuals must be married to have a family or couple membership.
 - 2. For children to be part of the family membership, they must be full-time students for the semester or the quarter directly preceding the summer for which the parents have a family membership.
- D. Student membership
 - 1. For a person to play for a student fee, they must be in school as a full-time student directly preceding the summer they are requesting membership.

VIII. PLAYING TIME

In order for everyone to enjoy their round of golf, we ask that you play ready golf. Nine holes of golf should not take more than **2 hours 10 minutes**. If you are not able to keep up, you may be asked to skip a hole.
