

Long Prairie Country Club Policies 2021

General Policies

I. TEE TIMES

- A. Stockholder members may make tee times 30 days in advance.
- B. Non stock members may make tee times 20 days in advance.
- C. Nonmembers may make tee times 14 days in advance.
- D. Special circumstances allow where the manager will make tee times further in advance to accommodate large groups.
- E. If you show up at the course without a tee time clubhouse personnel will schedule you for the first available tee time. You will not be allowed to just begin play on any hole.
- F. If you have a scheduled tee time and the weather is questionable or you are unable to keep your tee time you are requested to go online or call the clubhouse to cancel your tee time.
- G. All members are required to make tee times online with our booking engine or call ahead for tee times. If you do not make a tee time you will need to wait for the first available tee time on the tee sheet after checking in at the clubhouse.

II. GENERAL COURSE DAY

- A. Fivesomes will be allowed on the golf course under the discretion of the club manager and or staff. It is mandatory that three carts are in each group. There will be no more than 2 leased carts allowed per foursome and 3 leased carts per fivesome.
- B. All golfers must “**sign in**” in the pro shop before teeing off. You are encouraged to be at the course a minimum of 10 minutes prior to your tee time.
- C. Upon checking in, pro shop staff will direct you to the designated starting hole.
- D. All beverages consumed on the course or bar area must be purchased through the country club. All others will be confiscated.
- E. Each golfer must have their own set of clubs. Rental clubs are offered.
- F. Golfer’s 15 and under must be accompanied by an adult on weekends and holidays.
- G. Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times on the course and clubhouse.
- H. Metal spikes are not allowed. This is a soft spike facility.

III. SPECIAL DAYS

- A. Wednesday's are Men's days. On this day men are able to pre-book standing tee times for the season. All other available tee times on the tee sheet that are not taken will be used for the general public. Women are allowed to golf on men's day.
- B. Thursday's are ladies' day. On this day women are able to pre-book standing tee times for the season. All other available tee times on the tee sheet that are not taken will be used for the general public. Starting hole of #1 or #10 for the day will be determined by clubhouse personnel. Men are allowed to golf on ladies' day.
- C. Tuesday evening is the match play league. The 9 holes the league plays on the last available tee time is 3:00 PM. The other 9 holes will remain open to the public. Clubhouse personnel must schedule golfers stating the holes the match play league is on must be vacated by 5:00 PM.

Note: If any special day falls on a legal holiday, holiday play takes preference for the clubhouse and course.

IV. PGA HANDICAP IS NEEDED FOR THE FOLLOWING:

- A. Men's League
- B. Tuesday League
- C. All LPCC sponsored tournaments

V. POWER GOLF CARTS

- A. Rented and leased Carts
 - 1. All carts must be driven by a person 18 years of age or older. Carts may be driven by persons between 16 and 18 years of age provided they can provide a valid driver's license.
 - 2. Cart keys must be returned to the clubhouse after completing the golf round.
- B. No more than two persons allowed on a cart at any time.
- C. Members who use their own carts will be charged a daily (\$10) or annual trail fee.
- D. Non-Members who use their own cart will be charged a daily trail fee (\$10).
- E. LPCC requires that personal carts not be loaned to others, other than immediate family.
- F. Power carts are to remain at least 30 feet from the green, unless on a path.
- G. Those paying for single seat cart rental for the season may not let others ride in the other seat for free. Those others must pay a normal ½ cart rental fee. Couples with LPCC couple's membership may share one seat rental for the season. If both are using the cart than one must pay for one seat for the round.

- H. Any family member can ride in the cart if that family or couple has paid for a full two seat cart rental for the season. Guests that are non-family members will pay a daily trail fee.

VI. MEMBERSHIP

- A. There shall be single memberships, couple memberships, family memberships, intermediate memberships, student memberships, social/bridge memberships and driving range memberships. Corporate memberships are also available. Refer to separate Corporate/Business Membership document for specific details. Prices will be reviewed each year.
- B. Family and Couple memberships
1. In order to have a family or couple membership, the individuals must be married.
 2. For children to be part of the family membership, they must be full-time students for the semester or the quarter directly preceding the summer for which the parents have a family membership.
- C. Student membership
1. For a person to play for a student fee, they must be in school as a full-time student directly preceding the summer they are requesting membership.
- D. Intermediate membership
1. Must be in the ages from 19 - 35 to qualify for this membership.
- E. Social/Bridge Memberships.
1. Fee allows the use of the clubhouse for up to 17 days of bridge play. Dates scheduled by clubhouse manager
- F. Range Fee Membership
1. Check in to get balls from the clubhouse. If a cart is rented it can be driven to the range. If a cart is not rented you should drive an auto to the range.

VII. MEMBERSHIP PAYMENT PLANS

- A. Membership payment plans are available with payments through direct deposits from a bank on the first of each month. Payments can begin on the first of any month with full membership payment completed on September 1st. Failure to make on time payments will result in loss of golfing privileges.

VIII. PLAYING TIME

- A. In order for everyone to enjoy their round of golf, we ask that you play ready golf. Nine holes of golf should not take more than **2 hours 10 minutes**. If you are not able to keep up, you are asked to skip a hole or let golfers play through.

IX. CLUBHOUSE RENTAL

- A. Clubhouse rental is available to all members and the general public. See room rental contract for specific details.

X. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

- A. Current board of directors receive a 10% off posted price on pro shop purchases. Golf or cart rentals are not included.

XI. CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

- A. In order to play in the Club Championship, you must be 18 years of age, have a PGA handicap (if no handicap you play as a scratch golfer) and be a LPCC stockholder or non-stock member with dues paid in full. Corporate/Business members are not eligible unless they are the owner of the corporation paying the membership. The only exception will be if there is a Junior Club Championship held, the winner of that will qualify to play in the Club Championship.

XII. PUNCH CARD CERTIFICATES

- A. Punch card certificates can be purchased at the clubhouse.
- B. Certificates are valid only during the year purchased.
- C. Punch card outing is transferable to guest only when purchaser is present.
